OVERVIEW

SPECIAL NOTES!

This aircraft is **ONLY** compatible with Microsoft Flight Simulator 2004: Century of Flight!

It will **NOT** work properly in Microsoft Flight Simulator 2002, Standard OR Professional!

INSTALLATION

In order to properly install our aircraft, please follow the following steps closely.

Step #1

Extract this zip file to your main FS2004 folder. The files will automatically be put in their respective areas.

Step #2

In order for you to take advantage of the several animations on our aircraft, you must ensure that you have a key bound to your “Wing Fold” Command.

Go to the Options-> Controls-> Assignments menu

-At the bottom of the "General aircraft commands", you will find the "wing fold" command.

The passenger doors animate with the following commands; L2= Shift+E, L1= Shift+E+2

The cargo doors and galley service doors open with the FOLDING WING command.
